Ms. Anku Nath serves as USIBC's Director for Trade Policy Advocacy. In this role, she leads the Council's Strategic Trade Initiative which aims to address the principle trade and investment barriers of commercial significance facing USIBC member companies, while facilitating broadly inclusive growth for both the U.S. and India. She also launched and now runs the Council's Food & Agriculture and Retail Trade portfolios, leading the policy advocacy efforts of several dozen member companies engaged in these sectors. In addition, Anku manages USIBC work on inward investment from India and the ongoing negotiations of a Bilateral Investment Treaty.

Prior to joining the Council in 2007, Anku worked as a Senior Consultant in IBM's Global Business Services unit, focusing on federal government financial planning, strategic planning and economic modeling. Before her tenure at IBM, she developed quantitative models for antidumping & countervailing duty and contract dispute settlement casework at LECG, LLC (Law and Economic Consulting Group) in both Washington, DC and London, England, where she also contributed to casework focused on President Bush's landmark Section 201 steel remedy decision. Anku has also worked on similar international trade models at Georgetown Economic Services.

Anku earned a B.A. in International Economics, magna cum laude, from the Elliott School of International Affairs at the George Washington University, an M.Sc. in Statistics from the London School of Economics, and an M.A. in International Trade & Investment Policy also from the Elliott School. She is a member of the Washington International Trade Association, the American Statistical Association and sits on the Board of Directors of the Association of Women in International Trade.
